















Maintenance Vocabulary

<p>Adapter (unauthorized)</p>		<p>a device used to match the physical or electrical characteristics of two different things so that a connection may be made between them. (www.wikipedia.com) There is no surge protector on this type of adapter, and is, therefore, prohibited.</p>
<p>Baluster</p>		<p>closely spaced supports for a railing.</p>
<p>Cove Base</p>		<p>rubber cover on the wall where the wall meets the floor.</p>
<p>Diffuser/Prismatic</p>		<p>(in a lighting fixture) any of a variety of translucent materials for filtering glare from the light source. (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Door Closer</p>		<p>a device, usually hydraulic or pneumatic, for controlling the closing of a door and preventing it from slamming. (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Heat Sensor</p>		<p>a device that detects heat, which responds to rapid changes in ambient temperature and/or the ambient temperature reaching a predetermined threshold. (www.wikipedia.com)</p>
<p>Horn Strobe</p>		<p>a device that emits the horn noise and light strobe when the alarm is triggered.</p>

<p>Louver</p>		<p>any of a series of narrow openings framed at their longer edges with slanting, overlapping fins or slats, a ventilating turret (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Mullion</p>		<p>a nonstructural vertical strip between the casements or panes of a window (or the panels of a screen) (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Panic Bar</p>		<p>a bar that spans an emergency exit door on its interior and opens the latch when pressure is applied. (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Partition</p>		<p>an interior wall or barrier dividing a room, area of a building, enclosure, etc., into separate areas.</p>
<p>Pull Station</p>		<p>an active fire protection device, usually wall-mounted, that, when activated, initiates an alarm on a fire alarm system. (www.wikipedia.com)</p>
<p>Receptacle Cover</p>		<p>a contact device installed at an outlet for the connection of a portable lamp, appliance, or other electric device by means of a plug and flexible cord. (www.dictionary.com)</p>
<p>Sprinkler</p>		<p>any of various devices for sprinkling, as a watering pot, a container of water with a perforated top used to sprinkle clothes before ironing, or esp. a perforated ring or small stand with a revolving nozzle to which a hose is attached for watering a lawn with a fine, even spray.
