

A GUIDE TO CLEANING YOUR APARTMENT IN SAUCON VILLAGE

Kitchen & Living Room:

- Countertops and around faucet
- Stove top, fan/hood, inside the oven
- Inside and outside the refrigerator
- Vacuum carpet and/or mop and/or sweep floors
- Windows and windowsills
- Stove top (CeramaBryte)



Bedroom:

- Wash bedsheets
- Wipe down furniture
- Vacuum carpet and/or mop and/or sweep floors
- Windows and windowsills with Windex

Bathroom:

- Toilet
- Mop floor
- Mirror
- Sink and vanity
- Bathtub, walls of shower, and around caulking around edge of tub
- Shower head and faucet
- Shower curtain

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It is also important to make sure to dust regularly. Dust can accumulate on surfaces, corners, and in air vents.

YOUR BATHROOM:

WHAT TO CLEAN AND WHAT TO USE

The bathroom has many different surfaces which get dirty quickly. Cleaning regularly is necessary to prevent mold and mildew from growing.

Floors:

- A mop and designated floor cleaner like Pledge or Pine Sol, or a wet Swiffer, can be used in your bathroom and on any other hard surface floors in your apartment.



Toilet:

- Use a toilet cleaner and brush to clean the inside. For the outside, use a rag and a multi-surface cleaner or a disinfecting wipe.



Mirror, sink, and vanity:

- Use Windex to clean your mirror and faucet and a spray like Clorox disinfectant to wipe down the countertop.



Bathtub and Shower:

- The main things you will need to clean your shower and tub are a cleaner with bleach and a scrub brush.
- Spray the tub and use the scrub brush to get rid of any soap scum build up. Clean the seal between the tub and the wall, called caulking, with the bleach and the brush to prevent mold growth. Do this around the drain and hair-catcher as well.
- Windex can be used to wipe down the faucet. Wipe showerhead regularly. Keep shower liner inside tub.
