LOCKOUTS:

PERSONAL PROPERTY INSURANCE:




The University does not carry insurance on student's property and does not compensate students for belongings lost to theft, fire, flood, or other damage.

Unfortunately, these events can sometimes occur. Check your guardians' homeowners insurance to see if your property is covered while you are a student at Lehigh.

KITCHEN SAFETY:

If you choose to use the kitchen in your Residence Hall, avoid false alarms by:

-  Cooking at a lower heat
-  Never leaving food unattended
-  Using the hood fans and opening windows to avoid smoke build-up

NEED TO KNOW FROM THE GPO

Prohibited Items:

- LED Adhesive strip lights due to the damage they cause
- Candles of any type (religious, memorial, decorative, etc. should NOT be brought to campus
- Appliances with heating elements (electric kettle, microwave, heater, rice cooker, etc.) except in building or apartment kitchens.
- Personal air-conditioners

MICROFRIDGE RENTALS

While mini-fridges are allowed (4.6 cubic feet or less), separate microwaves are not. Students who wish to have a microwave must purchase a [MicroFridge](#), which will be delivered directly to your room before you move in.
